



Raspadskaya Coal Company enters the Russian Book of Records

2 November 2021 – An art exhibition has opened at Osinnikovskaya mine of Raspadskaya Coal Company (RUK, which operates EVRAZ's coal business). Paintings of the Novokuznetsk artist Ilya Hrabry were placed 900 meters underground. No other exhibitions has ever taken place in the country before. The experts of the Russian Book of Records recorded the achievement.

The exhibition is dedicated to mining work: tunnels, galleries of the washing plant, gigantic mining dump trucks. The artwork is done in black and white graphics. Thanks to underground wi-fi and with the help of special smartphones and tablets, pictures can be brought to life: A QR code on the canvases links to a video that tells how the works were created.

The Osinnikovskaya mine is today a platform for many digital pilot projects. Information technologies here support process, maintenance and transport management projects, which facilitate the work of miners, improve performance and ensure the safety of operations. The mine's product, Zh grade coking coal, are in demand among steelmakers. After washing, it is shipped in the form of concentrate to EVRAZ's Mills and to third-party consumers in Russia and Southeast Asia.

Raspadskaya Group comprises enterprises of a single territorial production complex in Kemerovo Region and the Republic of Tuva of the Russian Federation: eight mines, two open-pit mines, three processing plants, transport and industrial infrastructure enterprises.
